EARLY VOTING

For the first time ever in New York State, early voting is available – and underway!

Early Voting Schedule:

--Sat. and Sun. Oct. 26 & 27: Noon to 5 pm

--Mon. Oct 28, Wed. Oct 30 & Fri. Nov 1:
8 am to 4 pm

--Tues Oct 29 & Thurs Oct 31: Noon to 8 pm

--Sat. and Sun. Nov. 2 & 3: Noon to 5 pm

In Westchester County, early voters must vote at designated polling places:

>Bedford & Mt Kisco (& New Castle) voters:
Mount Kisco Town Hall, 104 Main Street
>Lewisboro & Pound Ridge voters: Pound
Ridge Town House, 179 Westchester Ave

>North Salem (& Somers) voters: Somers
Town House, 335 Route 202
